

Mill Rythe Holiday Village – Away Resorts

Entertainment Department Activity / Session Risk Assessments

Last Updated 6th February 2015

General Points and declaration:

- (1) There is no upper limit to the number of participants in any of the activities, in that, the instructor/leader of each session is not responsible for supervising the participants, but to lead in a proper fashion the activity. The responsibility of supervision remains and is stated in the terms of conditions of booking as remaining, at all times, with the parent or other adult charged with the legal responsibility of guardianship of the participant. The only restriction on participation is based upon licensed capacity of venue and age where the activity forms part of a club e.g. “PLAY Toddlerpops”, where the activities have been tailored for a particular age group.
- (2) The terms ‘instructor’ or ‘leader’ are used through this document, these words are used to cover the roles of Entertainment Team Member, Leisure Team Member, Entertainment Manager or Leisure Manager or any other nominated person or 3rd party deemed by the company to be suitable to provide in a safe, sensible and secure way, the activity mentioned.
- (3) External providers of Entertainment, such as a visiting cabaret or sports coaches are responsible, as part of their contractual obligation with Away Resorts, to assess and sufficiently minimise any potential risk to Away Resorts Guests and Employees. The risks that such providers of Entertainment are likely to generate are also minimised through the careful supervision of the provider whilst on site by a nominated person (Entertainment Manager or assistant in their absence) ensuring that Away Resorts policies and practices are adhered to and that any additional steps to minimise risk as outlined in this document are implemented.
- (4) This risk assessment is not in isolation to any other Away Resorts / Mill Rythe Holiday Village health and safety documentation, it is intended to supplement existing procedure with relevance to the specifics identified within the practices of the Entertainment Department.
